Purpose of Application: The owners would like to install a new septic system for the existing building. To permit the septic system in the proposed location, variances are required from setback to the municipal road as the property is small. Variances are requested to decrease the setback for a private sewage system from a roadway, 15 m (49.2') to **3.96 m (12.9'), 3.66 m (12.0'), 6.10 m (20.01'), 6.13 m (20.11')**; all as shown on the Site Plan prepared by JBF Surveyors, Ontario Land Surveyors, dated December 8, 2021.

- That if any archaeological artifacts are found during construction, that all development shall be halted immediately and the proper agency be contacted.
