- Review County & Township programs
- 2010 - 39% diversion rate
- 2022 - 54% diversion rate
- 2030 - 60% WMMP Goal diversion rate





Update on Datacall

- County/Township Blue Box Program transitions January 1, 2024
- RPRA advised the County not required to submit a Datacall for 2022
- County and Township staff gathered the data
 - County and township reports available



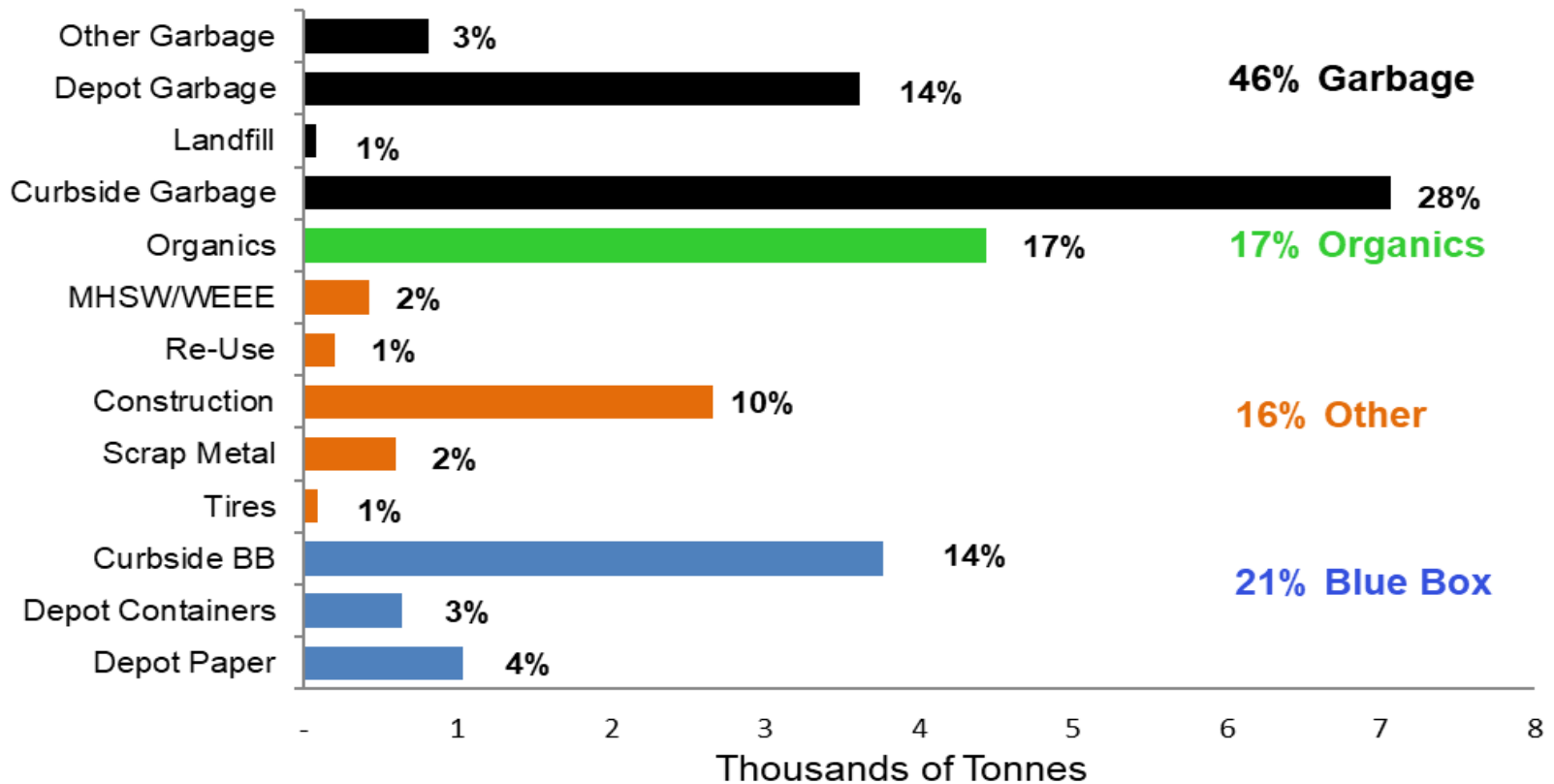
Blue Box Funding

2022

- Blue Box funding will continue in 2023 based on the 2021 Datacall
- \$1,257,471 in four installments of \$314,368

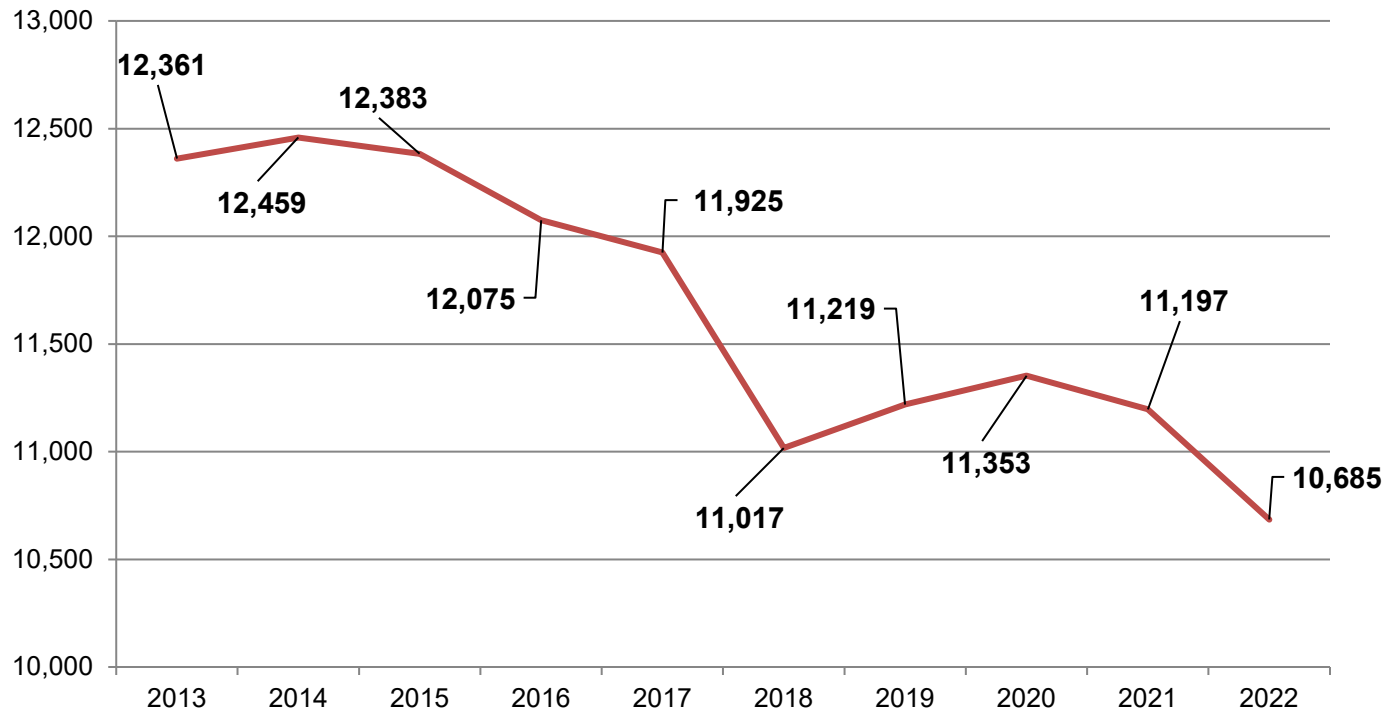
2022 Waste Composition

Garbage Generation 2013 to 2022

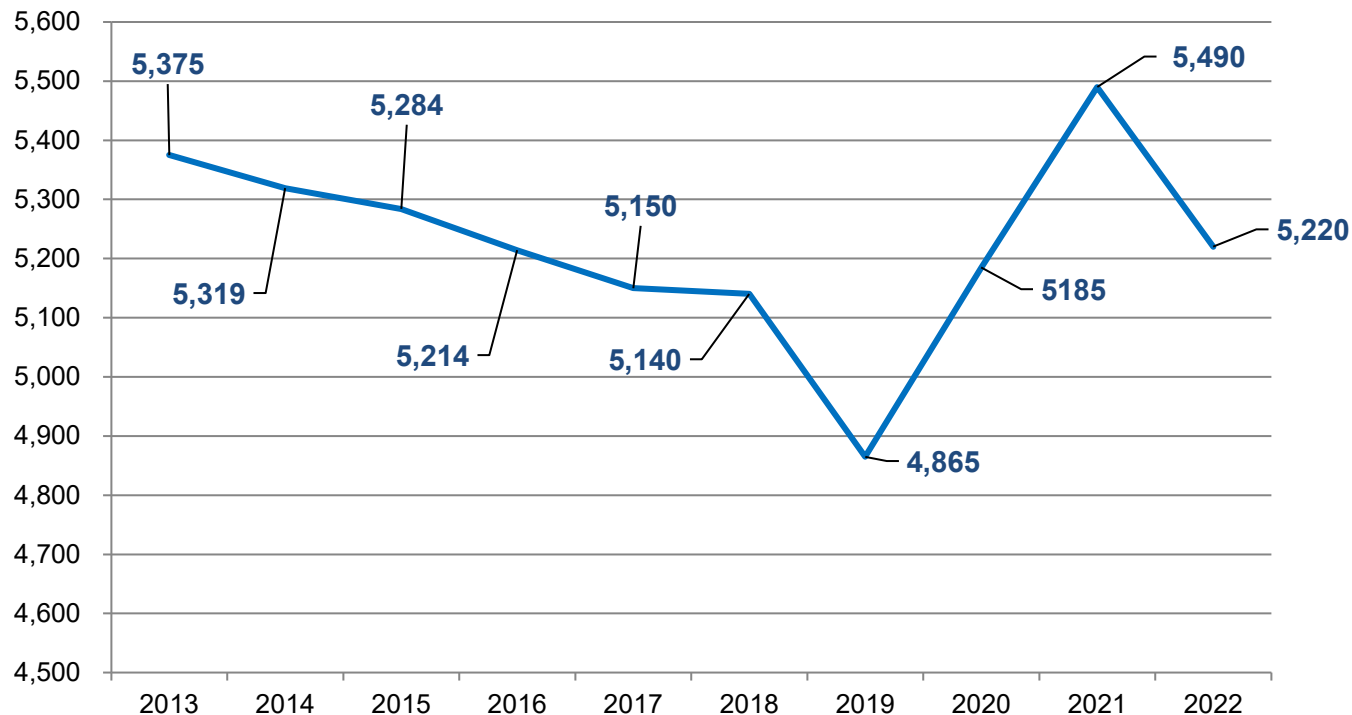
Garbage (tonnes)



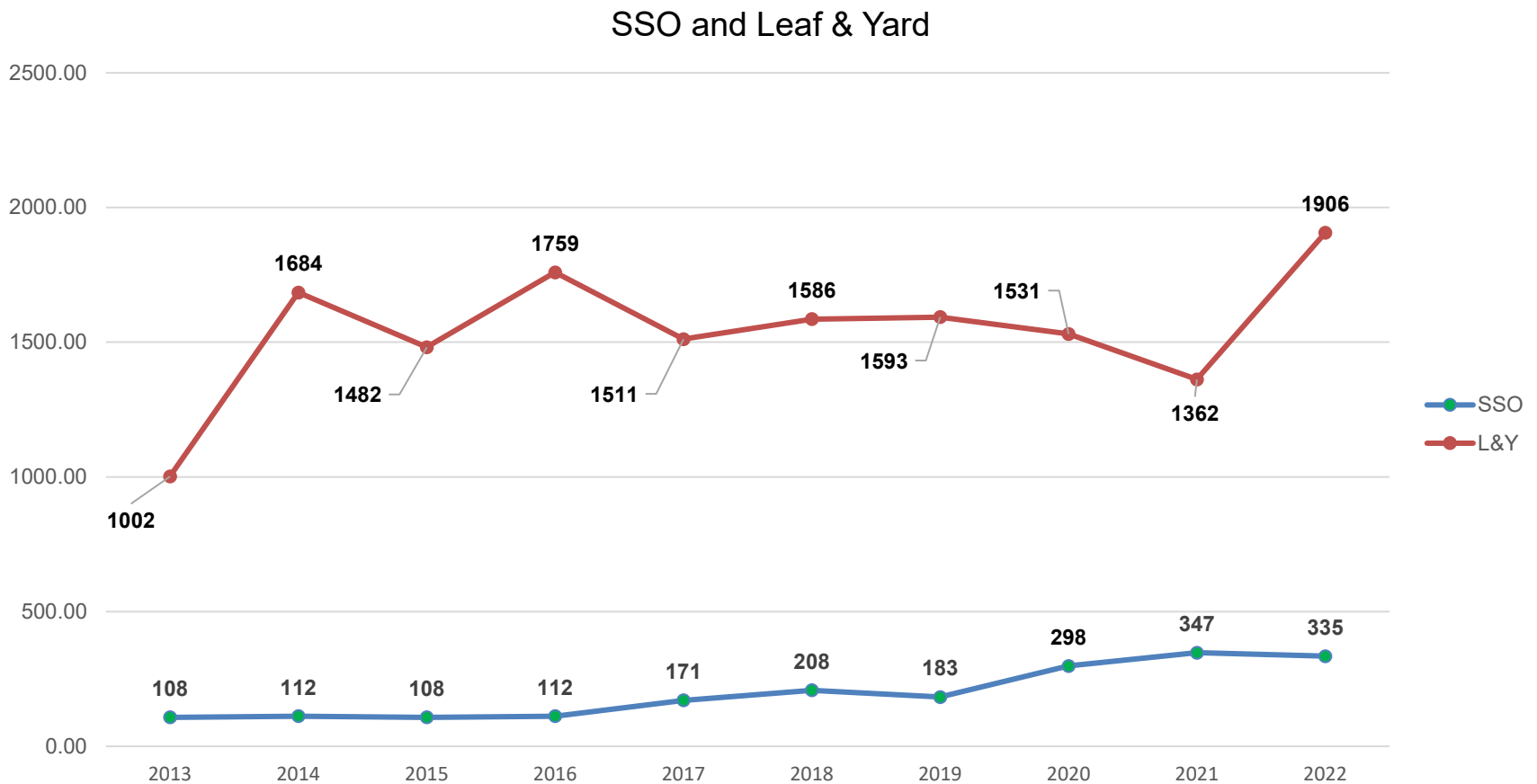
Blue Box Tonnes 2013 to 2022

2022 Highlights

- Garbage decreased from 11,196 MT in 2021 to 10,685 MT in 2022 (↓**513** MT!)
- Township diversion rates range from 43% to 61%
 - Yard waste a factor in 2022
- All townships are clear bags for garbage!
