

Departmental Update (April and May):

Administrative:

- Participate in weekly management and site meetings
- Completed interviews for labourer and seasonal staff

Operational:

- Removed, cleaned, stored plows, wings and other winter maintenance equipment
- Warsaw public works shop and yard clean up
